Youth General and Combo Level

General level with some experience, Intro/beginning to beginning-intermediate level.

Teen: General Level

General level with some experience, Intro/beginning to beginning-intermediate level.

Teen: Level 1 (Beginning to Intermediate)

Level 1 is for dancers who completed an intro/basic course and have an understanding of beginning level technique. This class progresses from a beginning-beginning level to an intermediate-beginning level.

Steps: Double pirouette, single-double chaîné, piqué turns, grand jeté, assemblé, double time step, riff walks.

Teen: Level 2 (Intermediate to Advanced)

Level 2 is for dancers who have completed an intermediate course and have an understanding of intermediate level technique. This class progresses from an intermediate-beginning level to an advanced-beginning level.

Steps: Triple pirouette, fouetté turns, tour jeté, second jump, pull backs and traveling time step.
